Samuel A. Marotta has a very long career in education and teaching and also has a long involvement with American Catholicism. He has studied at Loyola University of Chicago, the University of Michigan, Ann Arbor, Hochschule Sankt Georgen in Frankfurt, Germany, the Gregorian University in Rome. He has taught at Eastern Michigan University and the University of Michigan. He is still teaching for the University of Maryland, overseas at American Military posts in various countries and for the University of Georgia in Verona, Italy. He also taught here in the ASC 1994-1997, and is currently teaching for Open University of UW.

His primary areas of teaching deal with history, religion, philosophy and Italian Culture. He is a former Jesuit priest who has kept in contact with important Catholic Church reformers in the United States.
