Requirements:

- You have to be 2nd year student of BA program or 1st year student of MA program.
- You have to have grade average minimum 4.0.
 (BA students for 3 semesters, MA students for 1 semester)
- Citizenship: Polish only.
- Ability to pay for room and board in Gainesville (estimated USD 1,500 per month) plus airfare, health insurance and visa fee.
- Ability to provide a copy of bank statement with deposit of USD 6,000 or equivalent.

Documents needed for application to be submitted at the ASC office:

- 1. Letter of Intent. Please, explain why you want to study in Florida, what department, what type of courses you would like to take and how these will fit into your study program at the ASC in Warsaw.
- 2. List of courses you are interested in registering for, if accepted.
- 3. A copy of bank statement with deposit of USD 6,000 or equivalent.
- 4. CV with contact names and addresses, telephone numbers, 2 references.
