## EXPLANATIONS:

- All grades and credits are reported and recognized at the end of each academic year. The total of ECTS points required in two semesters is 60 . It means that even though some students fail their exams in the winter exam session, they should submit the request for conditional pass, or repeating the year (in case of the $3^{\text {rd }}$ year) only after they secure all the grades for the classes required in the summer semester.
- Students are required to get credit for the Health and Safety in the Workplace course (BHP) and Intellectual Property Protection (POWI) or submit a document certifying the completion of such courses at their earlier study programs at the University (if they have any).
- All courses in the program are assigned to two main areas: Humanities (H) and Social Sciences (S). They are visible in the table above.
- Elective courses (9 altogether) start in the second semester of the program. Students pick them according to their interests. However, each student is obliged to complete at least 2 electives from each group. It means, 2 electives from Humanities (H) and 2 electives from Social Sciences (S) + the remaining 5 from any group. Courses are marked H or S in USOS before registration. Some are classified as belonging to both groups H and S (H/S)
- Foreign Language Classes start in the second year. Students have to secure 4 semesters of language classes ( $4 \times 60$ hours/semester) in the language other than English. They can be taken earlier (eg. in the first year) but have to be reported in accordance with the program: two at the end of the second year and two at the end of the third year of studies.
- Language Certification Exam can be taken at any point of studies but no later than the end of the sixth semester. Moreover, there is no correlation between the foreign language taken and the exam. It means, a student may learn one foreign language during the studies and pass a B2 Certification exam in another, eg. the one a student learnt in high school. The Exam can be also taken in English at the minimum level C1.
- Physical Education classes start in the second semester of the first year. Students may take them earlier but cannot leave their passing till further in the studies. By the end of the first year students should report taking and passing one Physical Education class and two more by the end of the second year of studies.
- OGUN classes can be attended at any point in the studies but they must be reported in accordance with the program requirements. It means each student has to report min 3 ECTS points for OGUN at the end of the fourth semester and another 6 ECTS points at the end of the sixth semester. The total ECTS requirement for OGUN is 9 for BA studies. The number of courses taken to fulfill the requirement does not matter. Students may take one OGUN for 9 ECTS points or three OGUNs for 3 ECTS points.
- OZN points should be collected throughout the entire course of studies, yet, they are reported and recognized at the end of the sixth semester.
